This in-depth inductive Bible study will move through Mark's record of Christ's life and His ministry. The study will carefully observe the text in order to accurately interpret The Gospel According to Mark, the good news of Jesus Christ. The study will look for eternal principles that lead Christ's followers to a life of obedience. Mark's gospel was written to the early church in Rome, and also has relevance to Christians today.

The study will include many questions to bring personal application of Christ's teaching through Mark's historical and biographical narrative. The lessons also offer a reflection in Scripture in the study of the classical spiritual disciplines to challenge the student to grow in their faith as a mature disciple of Christ.

This inductive study will use the Bible as the primary source of information. The inductive method includes four steps. First you will be asked questions to help you carefully *observe* the text as you "read with a purpose." The next step involves careful and accurate *interpretation* of the Scriptures being studied, that you might determine *eternal principles* from the text, and then *apply* these Scriptures to the circumstances of your life.
