They lived centuries ago, so what can we learn from individual women in the Bible and what significance can their lives have for us today? We will be reflecting on the relevance of the Word of God as we study a number of different Old and New Testament “Women of the Word” using the Bible as our text.

Each lesson will include: The historical setting; The cultural setting; The geographical setting; Events in the woman's life; Her relationships with others; Her relationship with God; What is revealed about her character; and What is revealed about God's character with a Personal application for our own lives.

This inductive study will use the Bible as the primary source of information. The inductive method includes four steps. First you will be asked questions to help you carefully *observe* the text as you “read with a purpose.” The next step involves careful and accurate *interpretation* of the Scriptures being studied, that you might determine *eternal principles* from the text, and then *apply* these Scriptures to the circumstances of your life.
