Inductive Bible Study Orientation

Learn the inductive method of study as you study the book of Philemon. How does one study the Bible to determine God's purpose for a specific book in the Bible and then hide God's truth in one's heart? Try the inductive method of Bible study that equips Christians to grow stronger in their faith that they might share God's truth with others.

- Investigate what is involved in studying the Bible inductively.
- Move through a training methodology that helps one observe, interpret, look for eternal principles, and then apply God's word to life's circumstances.

Biblical Interpretation

How does the student of the Bible bridge the span of time between when the Bible was written and now? This seminar will help Bible students accurately interpret God's word.

Statement of Faith

Belief in the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ, that He ascended into heaven to be our High Priest and Advocate, that His physical return to earth is imminent, and that He will gather to Himself all who have followed Him as their personal Savior.

*The Greek word *sunergos* means *fellow workers*, used in the New Testament for believers who are working together for the sake of the gospel.
